

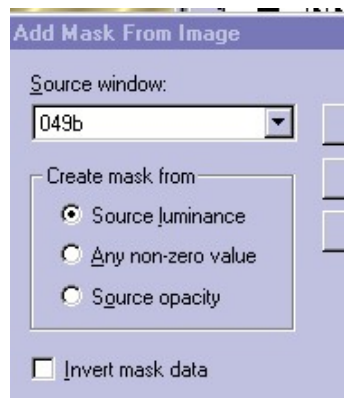
Turning black and white images into decorative graphics!

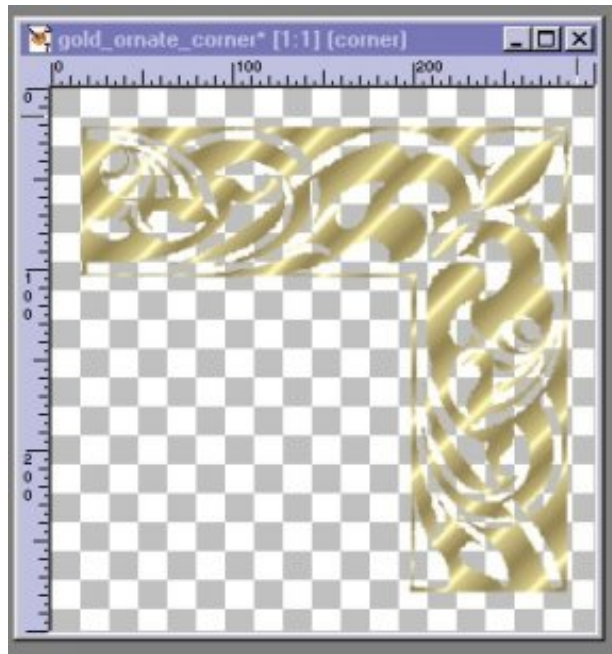
First open the black and white image you want to use, resize if necessary (some are rather large), then I open a new image about 200 x 200 and flood fill with the gold fold by Dee or any other pattern fill you wish to use. I put this one in my Patterns folder within PSP 7.



then, highlight your fill image and go to Masks/New from Image and this window will open and you will chose from the drop down window which image you are going to use, in this case, it 049b, click and your black and white image will show on your fill image.



This is what you should see, if not then go to Masks/Invert so the mask is gold and the background is not.



We need to go to Masks/Delete and it will ask you if you want to merge the mask with image layer. Click Yes. If you want to add a drop shadow just click Effects/3d/drop shadow. Next, add a new layer and move it below this image and call it fill. Now fill with any background you choose if you wish. I chose to use mine as a gif so I didnt' put a background on mine.

Hope this isn't confusing to anyone.
